

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The dummy trial will be judged according to the Field Trial rules.
- Each dog can be entered in different classes. On the other hand, it is not allowed to enter a dog in the Open class in one dummy trial and further on in the Novice class or viceversa. Skipping a class is not allowed.
- Field Trial Champion dogs **MUST** be entered in the Open class.
- Winners of at least one working test and/or a working test cup or dummy trial cannot be entered in classes lower than the class where they were awarded the first prize.
- Dogs that have been awarded EXCELLENT in a specific class cannot be enrolled in a lower class in the next competitions.
- The score obtained in the class where the dog was mostly entered will count towards the final ranking. If the dog was run in lower classes and a score was awarded, such score will be halved.
- In the Novice class, handlers are allowed to keep their dogs on the lead during the first retrieves. Nevertheless, judges may decide to ask the handlers to remove the lead in certain situations to determine the winning dog and the final ranking.
- In the Puppy class dogs **MUST** be kept on the lead.

SCORING SYSTEM:

Excellent = 7 POINTS

VERY GOOD = 4 POINTS

GOOD = 2 POINTS

ELIMINATED AND NC = 0 POINTS

1ST PLACE = 8 POINTS

2ND PLACE = 6 POINTS

3RD PLACE = 4 POINTS

4TH PLACE = 3 POINTS

5TH PLACE = 2 POINTS

Should two or more dogs reach the same place in the final ranking, the younger dog will be awarded the prize.
